### Pre-Primary ~ For ages 3 - 6

*Session 1: June 1st- June 25th, Session 2: June 28th - July 23rd, Session 3: July 26th - July 30th.*  
 Your child must be **3 years of age and fully potty trained** by the beginning of the session they will be participating in.

The Villa Montessori Pre-Primary program consists of three Montessori classrooms as well as a theme room with daily crafts! This program is an extension of our school year's pace, familiar surroundings and modified schedule, as well as a creative fun time. It includes movement, cooking, music and drama. 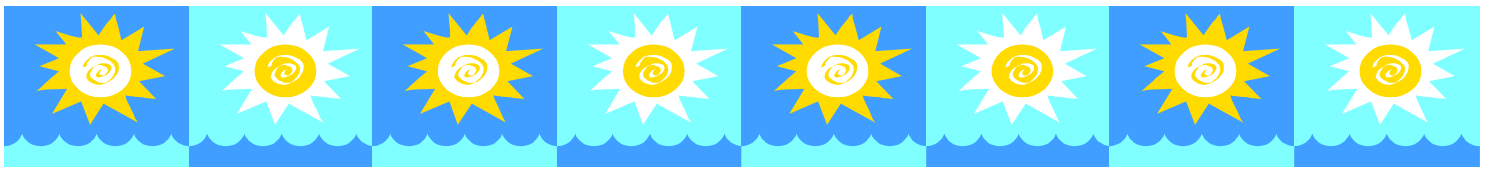
